Remit

To provide expert advice and guidance to support AHCS Regulation Board in the oversight of the STP Equivalence process, including meeting Health and Care Professions Council statutory annual monitoring requirements.

The Education Standing Panel will meet as frequently as required but not less than two times a year, and ahead of the Regulation Board meeting.

Terms of Reference

To critically review and provide comments on:

- STP Certificate of Equivalence Annual Quality review report and supporting documentation
- Annual Quality review action plan
- STP Equivalence guidance materials
- Any other matters relating to the STP Equivalence process

To provide advice and guidance in relation to future developments in the STP Equivalence.

Until 31 December 2020

To critically review and provide comments on:

- The final STP Certificate of Attainment Annual Quality review report.

Membership

To be determined by Regulation Board to include

- a lay representative
- a member with experience of the STP training programme
- a registered Clinical Scientist
- STP Equivalence Programme Lead
- AHCS Head of Standards
- a member of the AHCS Administration team - Secretary

Meetings

Meetings will take place virtually, normally via video-conferencing.

Action notes of the meeting will be taken identifying any further actions for panel members and

any recommendations for the Regulation Board. The notes of each meeting will be considered at the subsequent Regulation Board meeting.

The Panel can make recommendations to the Regulation Board but only the Regulation Board can sign off the HCPC reports for the Academy.
