

LSI Registration Council Meeting Tuesday 8th September 2020

Summary Report

1. Actions and minutes of the meeting held on 21st May were reviewed. The minutes were approved.
2. Covid-19 remains an issue for the industry. Agreed that further work on how industry can function in its relations with the NHS was necessary. A working group will be established.
3. Relations had been established with the NHS Regional Leads on Healthcare Science. Presentation at a recent online meeting had elicited genuine interest in the LSI Register and further contact with this group was planned.
4. A Review Group was proposed to follow up on outcomes from the Fitness to Practise Workshop held in 2019.
5. There had been no complaints about registrants since the last meeting.
6. LSI registrant numbers are 5,231 on Tiers 1, 2 and 3, with a further 5,700 in a pre-registration phase.(tier x)
7. Proposed revisions were presented for some LSI documents (QA Framework, Registration User Guide). Revision to required levels of DBS checks for the three Tiers were discussed. These will proceed subject to comment and approval from the Registration Council.
8. An extensive marketing and communications plan had been developed for implementation over the next year.
9. The next meeting was scheduled for 23rd November.
