

## LSI Registration Council Meeting Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020

### Summary Report

1. Actions and minutes of the teleconference held on 8<sup>th</sup> September were reviewed. The minutes were approved.
2. The Registrar confirmed that contact had been established with the authorities in Scotland and Wales. The objective was to work with them to promote recognition and use of the LSI Register in those territories.
3. The QA Framework had been revised and published following input from the Registration Council and a stand-alone version of the Training Matrix published.
4. The Registrar reported that external reviews would take place covering training and education and GDPR and information governance. The latter would be as part of an AHCS review of the same.
5. New arrangements were in place with MIL to cover logistical arrangements for processing registrations and issuing photo-ID cards. From 1<sup>st</sup> January membership of the MIA appointment booking system would require individuals to already be accepted on the LSI Register.
6. A new platform for the Register had been established and work was scheduled for improvement of the LSI website.
7. The number of registrants accepted on to Tiers 1, 2 and 3 continued to increase. Tier X would be retained as a 'pre-registration' status for the time being given the exceptional circumstances caused by the Covid-19 pandemic.
8. The next teleconference was scheduled for February 2021 but it was agreed to also hold short, interim teleconferences to report on and ensure progress on the key work items.
